- 1. Turn the ball valve to the BYPASS & DUMP/BY RAIL position. SURELOK disengages and the trailer air suspension simultaneously exhausts.
- 2. Visually check to ensure the SURELOK arms are disengaged and the air suspension is exhausted and resting on its internal air spring bumpers.

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
