

The upper and lower shock mount bolts MUST BE TIGHTENED to a torque value of 210 to 235 ft-lbs (285 to 319 N \cdot m). If the shock mount bolts are not properly tightened, failure of the shock absorber may occur that could damage the suspension and/or its components.

IMPORTANT: This torque value supersedes all previous torques for the shock mount bolts.
